

PRWIN August 2018 Updates

Currently PRWIN has (19) nineteen people signed up for the PTARP program this fall. The deadline for ordering is **August 30th**. Only one tree per property is the programs policy. We hope to encourage people to purchase more trees on their own once they receive their PTARP tree.

EcoAction 10

- (5) five berms to be created in Huron Kinloss
- PRWIN took benthic sampling of the 18 mile at two different sites that correspond to the berms/stream flow last Wednesday.
- Berms will be created after crops are off in mid/late September

- Livestock crossing to be completed this summer/fall
- Fencing completed spring 2018
- Planting completed spring 2018
